



Ready-To-Assemble Storm Window

We were contacted to fabricate Ready-To-Assemble (RTA Kits) for a project with HistoriCorps. This group was working on the Simpson Lake Lodge cabins and needed a product that they could use to make windows. However, whatever product they would use had to be easily transported because of the remote location.

The site is located on the east shore of Simpson Lake in the Wind River Mountains near Dubois, WY. The structures are currently part of the Shoshone National Forest. HistoriCorp had undertaken the restoration of the Simpson Lake Lodge cabins. The three buildings at this location were built in 1926 by three expert craftsmen who used hand tools to create exquisite detail in the main lodge and the two guest cabins. Most of the building materials--logs, stones, sand, etc. were gathered on site or from the immediate vicinity.

Due to the location, the cabins can only be reached by horseback. It was necessary to use pack animals to get all of the supplies to the cabins. Our RTA Kits are the long packages pictured here.

Since you do not have the weight of the glass nor the width of a completed window, our RTA Kits are less expensive to ship than other storm windows.
