

With the weather shifting back and forth between winter and spring, home owners are looking to improve energy efficiency. Many would also like to maintain the same look of their house or improve upon it. We recently completed a large bowed sash that was installed during a spring-like reprieve from the cold.



The installed finished product built to our customer's specifications. It will maintain the character of the house and have a positive impact on their heating bill due to the insulated glass. The view from the interior can be found below.

Project Details

We were asked to make a bowed window with tru-divided lites. The 21 lites are insulated glass with low-E coating. The size of the entire unit can be seen




better in other pictures, however, it measures 9 feet 7 inches wide by 6 feet 9 inches tall. It was fabricated from Sapele Mahogany and painted by the installer.

When the radius of the bowed sash is provided, we make a template to match. The wood is then carefully bent and glued up to obtain the necessary jamb depth. Once the exterior frame is completed, the muntins are added for each of the tru-divided lites.

The bottom row of lites are tempered glass in order to meet code because of how close the glass is to the finished floor.
