The first step in our process of creating a truly authentic product is for the estimator to gather as much information as possible from the customer. This involves both listening to your needs and asking the right questions to obtain style preferences and all details that are important for us to incorporate into the design.

The estimator will create a sketch based on this meeting and prepare information for our draftsman. In the computer-aided design (CAD) software, the draftsman will input all of the specifications for the door which include sizing, thickness, species, glass, ironwork, hinging, locking system, and much more! The drawing is reviewed by the estimator and then sent to the customer for review. Changes are made as necessary and a final sign-off by the customer is required before production begins. Our draftsman creates several documents for the shop that provide all of the specifications they require for cutting, joining, and assembly.

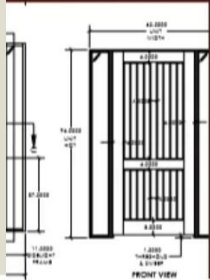
