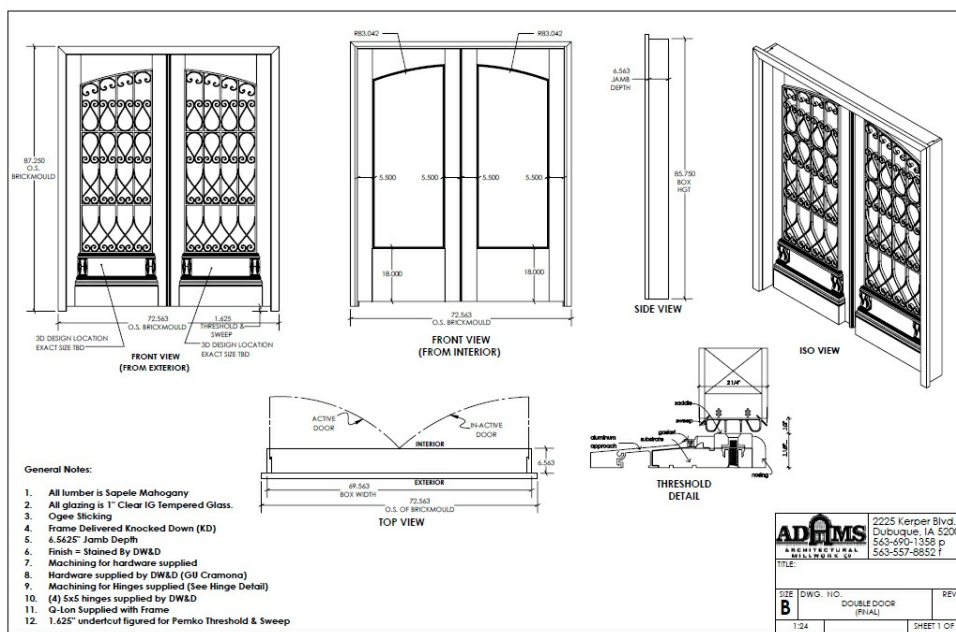
Taking Custom Millwork to the Next Level

This often results in opportunities to stylize our work in ways no other project can offer, and in the case of this Romanesque double door entry, it was all the more evident.

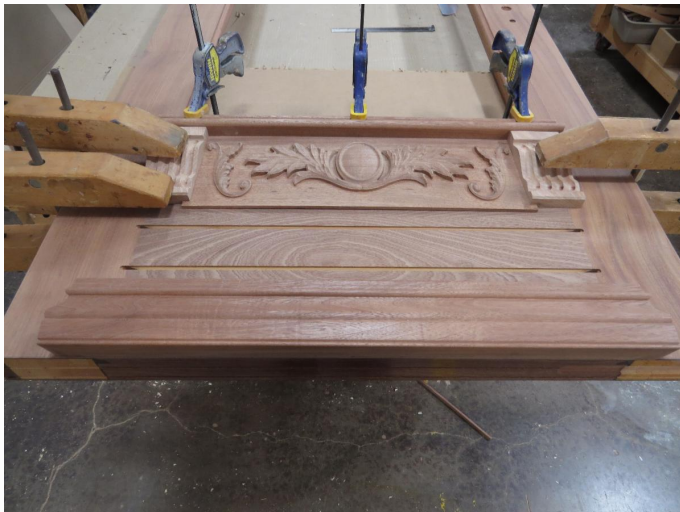
When we begin the process of fabricating any project, creating approval drawings is our starting point. Based on direction from our customer, these drawings show the exact dimensions and details of the entire job as it will be made in our shop. The approval drawing provides the customer with an idea of what to expect while the

shop gets a guide to make the concept come to life!



This beautiful door was fabricated from Mahogany. The gorgeous grain patterns in the wood are brought to life within the design on the lower panel of the door. Our CNC was used as a carving tool to create this effect.

The double door unit was 70" x 84" using insulated tempered glass with an arched top. The grill placed in front of the glass was decorative iron. The door was designed to match the transom and arched muntins above.



This 2-1/4" thick entry door boasts a multi-point locking system for security. We pre-drilled for hardware and the metal grill to be placed over the insulated glass prior to finishing. After the doors were sealed with a marine-grade varnish, all hardware was installed and the metal grill

was attached.

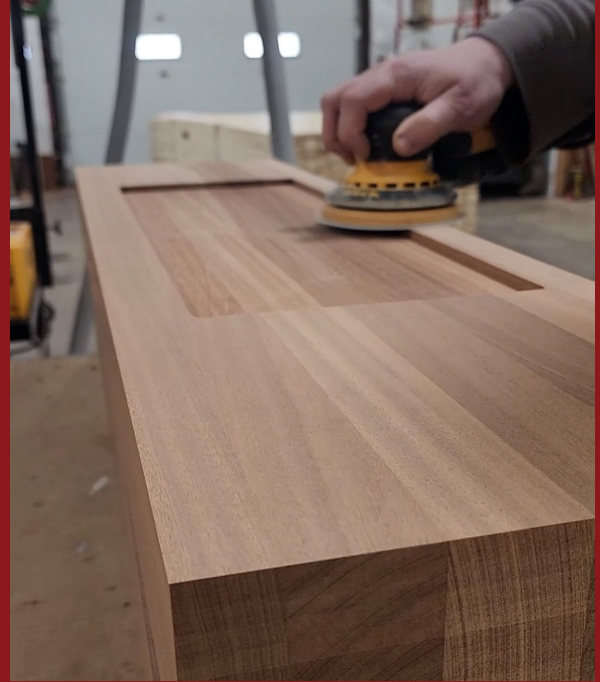


While our niche typically lies in the fabrication of windows and doors, we'll occasionally get projects in the shop that push us to go above and beyond the norm. Recently, we had the opportunity to make some custom stair treads that allowed us to go against the grain and show off our skills!

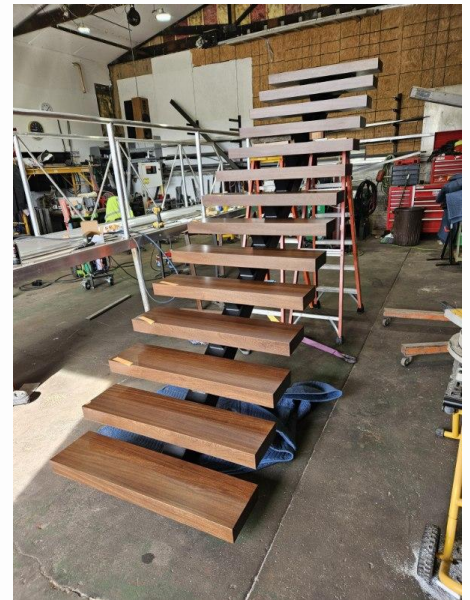
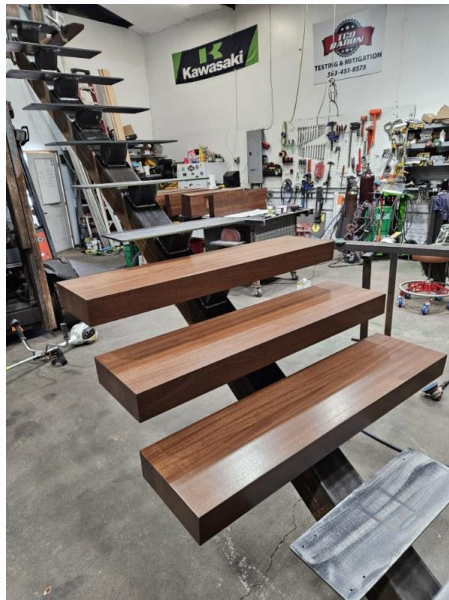
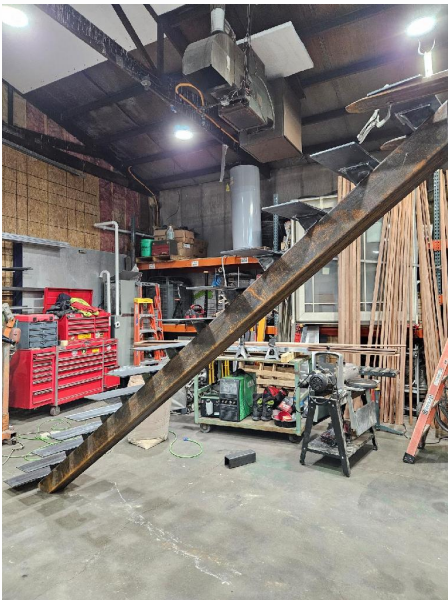
Check out our latest YouTube Short showing off the process of getting these stair treads glued up and assembled!



Fabricating the Mahogany stair treads to meet specifications: 11-1/2" deep, 42" wide, and 3" thick of solid lumber. Each tread weighed approximately 35 lbs and we made 14 stairs for a whopping 490 lbs of lumber alone!



Images below depict the assembly of these beautiful wooden stair treads onto the metal structure. As you can see from the photo above to the right, we routed a space for the stairs to be securely fastened to the framework. Prior to the stairs being assembled, the metal was powder-coated black for a striking finish.

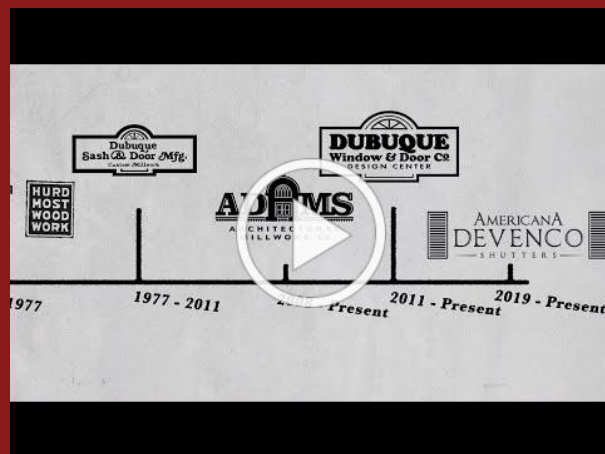
