



## Stately Carriage Garage Doors

Spring brings thoughts of cleaning and upkeep of the exterior of your home and yard. We became part of a project to make wood garage doors to replace what was existing. Carriage doors bring elegance and class to a home's appearance as well as a nostalgia for days past.

In carriage door fashion, these garage doors open on hinges rather than roll up. True divided lites and two large panels match other doors. The arched top and rich finish color set these Sapele Mahogany doors off to perfection.

Custom crafted at 2-1/4" thick, the double door measures 98" wide by 90-1/2" high. A solid wood core provides strength from warping, the insulating properties of wood increase energy efficiency, and the return on investment that a new garage door provides make this a good investment.

One of the highlights of Sapele Mahogany is the beautiful graining that can be seen in the doors. A final coat of marine-grade finish with UV inhibitors only enhances the appeal of these double doors.
