



Restoring Windows & Sash and Custom Shape Storm Windows

Adams Architectural Millwork has the expertise and tools to restore windows and sash to have them looking like new again. We can replace damaged or broken stiles, rails, or muntin bars as well as replace broken panes of glass in order to improve the quality of your window.

We also recommend storm windows for your home because they have many positive effects. They protect your original sash from the elements (bearing the brunt of the sun and rain/snow). Another benefit is increased energy efficiency which helps to keep your house warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer. And, while you remove your sash to repair or maintain them, a storm window can temporarily act as your main window to allow you to enjoy the view without having to board up the opening to keep your home secure.



Due to extensive moisture damage, which can be very common in original fixed windows and sash, we replaced the bottom third of this window with mahogany. The original configuration was matched and the original glass will be putty glazed back in place.



The top and bottom sash received new muntin bars. The profile of the existing sash was matched and the location of the muntin bars was maintained. Once the owner fills in some imperfections that have amassed over the years of use, the sash will be primed, the glass will be set and putty glazed in place, then given a couple coats of good paint. They will look as lovely as when these sash were first installed!



Properly clamping the repaired windows/sash is important to ensure the size remains the same as the original width and height and is not out of square. This will help certify that the sash or window can be easily placed back into the window jamb.
